*Royalties: Government Fees, Hunting Permit, Conservation, Concession and Community Development Fees, UWA & CITES Trophy Export Documents, Dip & Pack, 18% VAT, Car Transfers, Airport Pick-up and drop off, Rifle Import for two rifles per hunter and 18% VAT on the safari rate.

A deposit for your trophy fees and other expenses is required to be wired 10 days before the start of your safari. The deposit will be credited towards the trophies taken on your safari, and the balance if any is refundable. The balance outstanding to UWS is payable at the end of the safari in cash!


Non-Hunters/observers pay 350 US\$ per day inclusive of 20 US\$ Conservation and 20 US\$ Concession Fees.

Upgrades only: Hunters who finish their basic safari early can upgrade their safari for the respective fee only without paying Royalties for extra hunting days.

E.G.: 12 day Sitatunga Safari is finished early on day 4. You can then upgrade for the respective fee to a Lake Mburo or Karamoja safari!

All Safari Packages exclude:

- Any Charter Flights
- Hotel overnights before and after the safari
- Trophy Fees
- Tips to the Staff
- Any personal expenses
- Personal Insurances and Medical Evacuation coverage
- Any problems associated with delays due to weather, airlines, transportation breakdowns, emergencies, lost luggage
- Any expenses for overnights in lodges & national park entrance fees
- Trophy shipping expenses either to the US, Europe or any other place



TROPHY FEES

All trophy fees noted below include a 20% surcharge for anti-poaching projects. In case females or immature males are shot, the trophy fee is doubled.

Please note that trophy fees can change at any time without notification! Due to quota limitations (especially on Hartebeest, Sitatunga, Topi, Eland, Mountain Reedbuck and DikDik) please be advised, to book your safari well in advance and reserve the species on license you would like to hunt!

*Problem Animals: Crocodile, Hippos and Leopards can only be hunted when they are identified as problem animals by Uganda Wildlife Authority (which heretofore has been rare). Even if identified before or during a safari, it might be necessary to change the booked concession and permits for problem animals might not be available when clients plan to hunt.
